The Government of the Independent State of Samoa (GoS) has received financing from the Government of Australia (GoA) through DFAT, relating to an accountable cash grant for assistance regarding the provision of Emergency Modular Panel Type Bridges. All proceeds will go assist the GoS in procuring Emergency Modular Panel Bridges.

The Land Transport Authority (“the Employer”) now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the Supply of Modular Panel Bridges to the Land Transport Authority's Office located in Apia. Bids are welcome from Samoan and internationally based bidders, and can be in currencies other than the Samoan tala.

The description of goods include the following:

- 1) One (1) Modular Panel Bridge – Two Lane Carriageway width 7.35m, with external footway 1.5m. Total bridge length 6 Panels (approximately 18m) in complete set;
- 2) Two (2) Modular Panel Bridge – Single Lane Carriageway width 3.15m, with external footway 1.5m. Total bridge length 10 Panels (approximately 30m) in complete set;
- 3) One (1) Modular Panel Bridge – Two Lane Carriageway width 7.35m, with external footway 1.5m. Total bridge length 12 Panels (approximately 36m) in complete set ;
- 4) One (1) Modular Panel Bridge – Single Lane Carriageway width 3.15m, with external footway 1.5m. Total bridge length 12 Panels (approximately 36m) in complete set ;
- 5) One multi-purpose launching nose plus additional components as necessary to launch all the bridges as listed in items 1 to 4 inclusive above; and

- 6) Spare parts. The minimum number of spare parts shall be 10% of the total number of parts for all five (5) bridges listed above in items 1 to 5 inclusive.
- 7) Training in correct storage, installation, maintenance, inspection as well as de-launching and removal.
