Primary Objective	
	To work in collaboration with the Principal Engineer of Planning and Assets in planning and programming the Samoa Asset Management Systems ensuring accuracy and availability at all times of the system data which is critical to the development of the National Road Programme.

Responsibilities	
1	Assist the Principal Engineer of Planning and Assets to establish, maintain and utilize the Asset Management database for the LTA National Road projects to match (10 Year, rolling 3-5 Year and Annual Plans)
2	Establish a database to record and monitor all National Road Programs and to categories into their output classes for budgeting
3	Assist Senior and Principal Engineer of Planning and Assets regarding contract managements of all LTA assets from time to time.
4	Work in association with the Senior Engineer of Planning and Assets ensuring continuous improvement of processes and systems to get the best quality information from SAMS and continuously improve the integrity of the database
5	Maintaining the GIS component of the SAMS. This includes updating LTA Road Network Database both Upolu and Savaii, the MapInfo mapping, preparing maps and other output from GIS.
6	Assist in technical queries on SAMS and producing the necessary traffic analysis reports and other outputs to support the LTA staff in their decision making.
7	Assist the Principal Engineer of Planning and Asset by undertaking field works such as works within the Road Reserve observation and inspections, checking Utilities Alignment, Road Reserve Boundary.
8	Assist the Principal Engineer of Planning and Assets in the evaluation and implementations of the LTA's Contractor Registration Scheme.
9	Assist the Senior and Principal Engineer of Planning and Assets in any other works deemed necessary.
