<b>Reporting Structure</b>	The Quality Assurance Division for the effective and efficient supervision of all construction activities of the Road Operations Division to ensure the achievement and sustainability of the LTA's business goals and objectives.		

<b>Primary Objective</b>	
	To provide advice and assistance to the Manager Quality Assurance Division in the supervision of all the surveyor operations to be delivered within prescribed timelines, and make exact measurements and determine property boundaries.

<b>Responsibilities</b>	
1	Carry out road redefinition, topographical, land taking and leveling surveys as requested for LTA on going road works.
2	Execute and check all survey CAD drawings of Roads surveyed by the team and ensure it meets the specified survey accuracies.
3	Supervise and ensure all survey work done by survey teams meet specified accuracies.
4	Assist LTA tech teams on preparation of any survey related contracts with any outsourced survey work.
5	Assist LTA technical teams in execution of any new road design layout when necessary
6	Collaborate with PMD in execution and monitoring of world funded projects to ensure all survey related matters are dealt with.
7	Prepare and monitor the process of producing any survey plans until approval from MNRE
8	Collaborate with other utility service agencies carrying out works within the Road Reserve and working together with our Legal Division to resolve encroachment issues.
9	Manage and monitor movement of survey section personnel and equipment
10	Represent the QAD manager in any management meetings, site visits or wherever applicable when absent
11	Attend to all land and survey related issues required by LTA for contract execution and monitoring
